## \$130 (\$5.00 BI-WEEKLY)

- Nine hours of addiction counseling for one person
- One week of child care for a child with developmental disabilities
- One week of shelter, meals and counseling for a homeless veteran

## \$260 (\$10.00 BI-WEEKLY)

- Daily transportation to and from a senior center for one senior for 1 year
- One-on-one mentoring for three children
- One year of basic education instruction

## \$520 (\$20.00 BI-WEEKLY)

- Four nights of safe shelter for a battered woman and her child
- School year membership for two children to Boys and Girls Club
- 1,064 meals for the homeless

## ONLINE PLEDGING FAQ's

### • Where do I go to pledge online?

### • I want to give online and forgot my username and or password, where can I find that information?

Your user name is your employee ID. This information can be found on your pre-printed pledge card or on your pay stub. Your password is CCC plus your birthdate two digit month, day and year. For example, if you were born on September 14, 1972, your password would be CCC091472.

### • What is the deadline to pledge online?

The deadline is December 21, 2009 if you want your donation to be deducted the first pay in January 2010.

### • If I choose to pledge online, when will funds begin deduction from my paycheck?

Payroll deduction begins the first pay period in January of 2010.

### • Can I stop my payroll deductions? If so, how do I do so?

Contact your payroll administrator directly and inform them you want to stop your donation. Make sure to include your name, contact information and Employee ID.

## PARTICIPATING AGENCY DESIGNATION

If you want your contribution designated to a specific participating agency or agencies: carefully review the current Combined Charity Campaign Agency Directory and designate the agency or agencies of your choice with the appropriate number(s) in the spaces provided on the front of the pledge card.

BE SURE ALL NUMBERS ARE ACCURATE AND ANNUAL DESIGNATIONS DO NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF YOUR ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION.

If an agency not listed in the Combined Charity Campaign Agency Directory is designated, those funds will be treated as if NO designation (i.e. Undesignated) was made (NO WRITE-INS ARE ALLOWED).

The cost of running the Combined Charity Campaign last year was 24.9%. This compares favorably with the local average for non-profits of 15-30%.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Contributions to the Combined Charity Campaign are tax deductible within the limits of current federal and Maryland state law. The Combined Charity Campaign has provided no goods or services in exchange for your contributions.

You will be acknowledged for direct contributions made during the calendar year. Acknowledgements will be sent before January 31 of the following year. To assure receipt of your acknowledgement please provide us with your full home address.

If your contribution is being made by payroll deduction, you should keep the tear-off receipt from the bottom of the pledge card which, along with your pay stubs, show the amount withheld for your contribution. This will provide the necessary support for your contribution for Federal income tax purposes. The Combined Charity Campaign does not provide goods or services in return for any contribution made to it by payroll deduction.
